



#### **Executive Order 14005: Buy America Requirements and NIST MEP Supplier Scouting**

#### Executive Order 14005 – Buy America Requirements

On January 25, 2021, the White House announced Executive Order (EO) 14005, called *Executive Order on Ensuring the Future is Made in All of America by All American Workers*. EO 14005 establishes a substantial role for the MEP National Network<sup>TM</sup> in the Biden Administration's plans to bolster American manufacturing:



Sec. 7. Supplier Scouting. To the extent appropriate and consistent with applicable law, agencies shall partner with the Hollings Manufacturing Extension Partnership (MEP), discussed in the Manufacturing Extension Partnership Improvement Act (title V of Public Law 114-329), to conduct supplier scouting in order to identify American companies, including small- and medium-sized companies, that are able to produce goods, products, and materials in the United States that meet Federal procurement needs.



# RESHORING PRODUCTION Providing Resilience in the Face of Global Disruption

- In early 2022, FloridaMakes was approached by a Northeast Florida manufacturer who had been sourcing cast parts from Ukraine (Kharkiv region). As a result of the Russian invasion of Ukraine in February 2022, that source of components was cut off overnight.
- After substantial search and review of potential suppliers within Florida, no suitable alternatives were found within our state. However, through the Connex Marketplace national platform, FloridaMakes and the manufacturer were able to find a handful of domestic casting suppliers in the upper Midwest (Illinois and Indiana) who would be viable alternatives. Although those suppliers did have lead times of a few months in order to be able to produce the parts, that was vastly preferable to the uncertainty regarding availability and timeline(s) in sourcing from an active war zone.
- Production of these components (including final machining) was successfully reshored to the United States.





#### CASE STUDY: SOURCING DEFIBRILLATORS FOR DISASTER RESPONSE

Shortly after landfall of Hurricane Ian in Florida in September 2022, Florida authorities needed to set up and equip field hospitals to provide emergency medical care after several medical facilities in Southwest Florida were damaged or rendered inoperable due to the severe flooding, wind damage and other impacts of the storm.

Defibrillators and related accessories were identified as an immediate need (for delivery within 48 hours). Authorities reached out to FloridaMakes (the Florida MEP center) for help in filling this need, and through outreach across the country through the MEP National Network and Connex Marketplace, a connection with Zoll Medical Corporation, a defibrillator manufacturer in Massachusetts was established within hours and the needed units were identified, packaged and delivered within 48 hours (and less than 72 hours after the storm's arrival) for deployment at field hospitals across the impacted area.
