Phase 2: 04 March - 08 March 2024 Downselect: Subject Matter Experts will select those respondents/submissions they feel have the highest potential to satisfy a diverse range of STEM focus areas. Favorably evaluated submissions will receive an invitation to attend the SOFWERX STEM Showcase on/around 11 March.
Phase 3: 9 May 2024 Booth Set up at SOFWERX: Selected participants can set up between 12:00-5:00 PM. Tables, chairs, power, and commercial internet are provided.

SOFWERX and USSOCOM leadership will be selecting the opportunities that will benefit students. We will be looking for a wide range of technology as well as various company sizes (from non-traditional to DOD Primes).

8. Which schools are coming?

We don't have a final list yet, but the majority of the students will be from the Tampa Bay area.

9. Can we demo?
