Description



The Engage SOF process, also known as eSOF, is the digital front door to USSOCOM industry engagement. The Engage SOF team assists USSOCOM with market research in accordance with FAR Part 10.001 and in support of its mission to acquire, distribute, and support SOF-peculiar supplies and services. eSOF is the process through which to present **UNCLASSIFIED** information on capabilities to SOF Acquisition, Technology, and Logistics (SOF AT&L) Program Executive Offices (PEO), Directorates and other USSOCOM organizations.

USSOCOM Authorities

USSOCOM is mandated to develop, acquire, field and sustain technology in support of USSOCOM mission objectives and Title 10 USC, Section 167, vests the USSOCOM Commander with the responsibility and authority for: the development and acquisition of Special Operations (SO)-peculiar equipment; the authority to exercise the functions of the head of agency; and the authority to execute funds. The Commander has delegated those authorities to the USSOCOM Acquisition Executive who leads SOF AT&L and Congress has provided USSOCOM with the specific appropriation funding, Major Force Program-11, to support the development, acquisition, and sustainment activities for SOF peculiar equipment. This funding gives the Command the ability to optimize equipment in order to satisfy the Command's unique mission requirements, and carry out acquisition functions in a streamlined fashion.

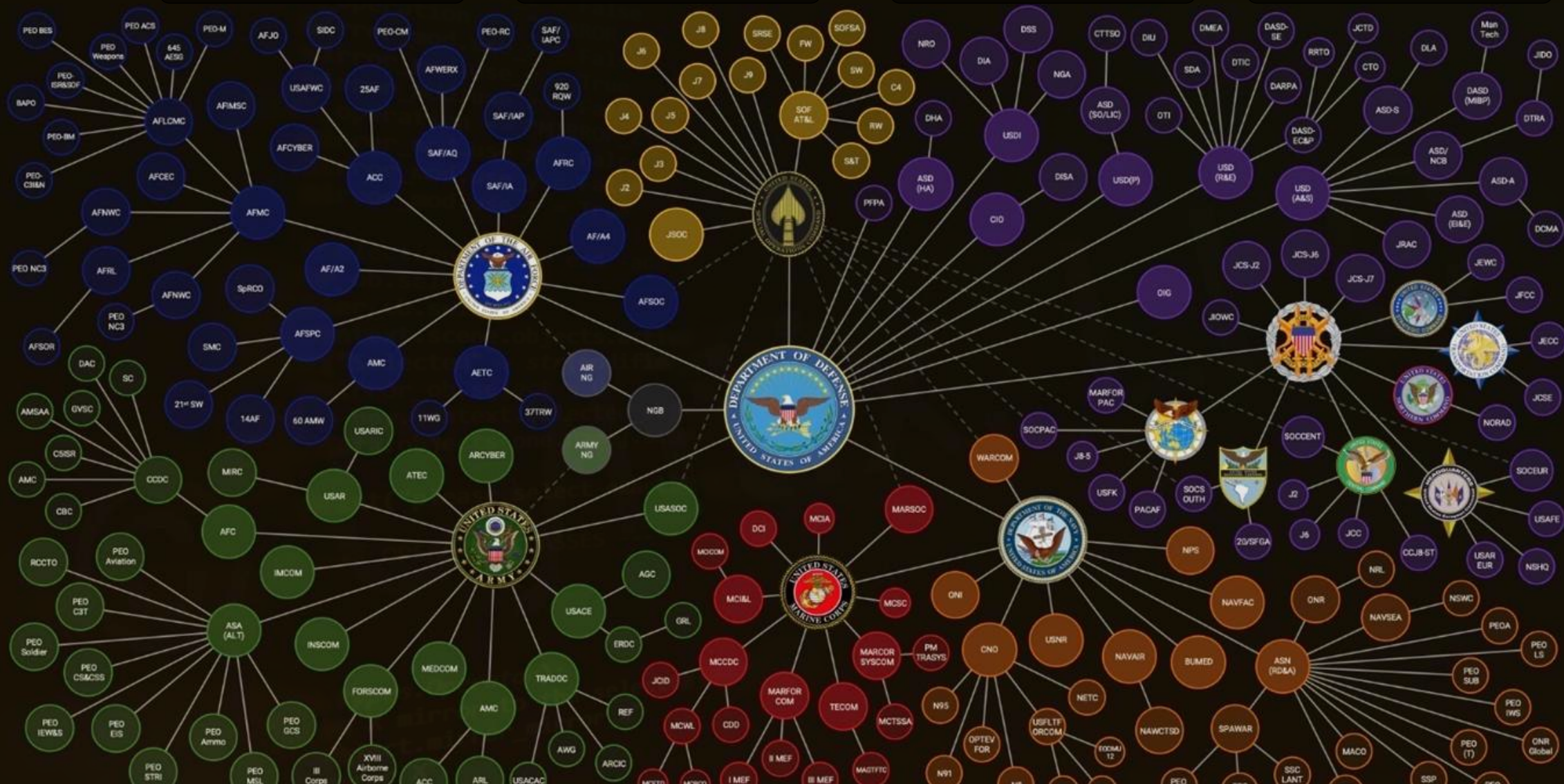
